Title 1 - Federal Funds

- *Purpose of Title 1 Federal Funds*
 - *Support effective, evidenced based educational strategies*
 - *Close the achievement gap*
 - *Enable students to meet challenging academic standards*
 - *Support the needs of at-risk and low-income students*
- *Allocation - Based on Enrollment*
 - *Funded schools are either Targeted Assistance or Schoolwide Programs*
 - *California Elementary - Schoolwide Program*

Single Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA)

Title 1 funds are allocated in the SPSA based on:

- *Comprehensive needs assessment*
- *Evidenced based strategies to strengthen academic programs*
- *Address the needs of all students*
- *Goals and actions to improve student outcomes*
- *Proposed expenditures*
- *Approved by School Site Council and Board of Education*

The State of California School Dashboard

State accountability system launched by the California State Board of Education and the California Department of Education

- *Multiple measurement system*
- *Assists with identifying strengths and areas of need*
- *Based on system of continuous improvement*

California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress CAASPP

Established January 2014 in California Education Code

Primary Purpose - to assist teachers, administrators, students, and parents by promoting high quality teaching and learning through the use of a variety of assessments

Smarter Balanced Assessments (SBAC)

California Science Test (CAST)

California Alternative Assessment (CAA)

Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium (SBAC)

Multiple states worked collaboratively to develop a student assessment system aligned to state standards

Computer adaptive technology designed to measure student progress

*Performance Levels: Standard Met or Standard Exceeded
 Standard Nearly Met
 Standard Not Met*

Percentage of Students Meeting and/or Exceeding Standards

English Language Arts (ELA)

From 46% to 58%

Increased by 12.56%

Mathematics

From 35% to 49%

Increased by 13.42%
